Scholarship Levels

Background: The Professional Association of Diving Instructors (PADI) offers a multilevel scholarship program to introduce Boy Scouts, Venturers, and Sea Scouts to the exciting underwater world. PADI recognizes that adventure is one of the key elements of Scouting and scuba diving is an exciting avocation or vocation that can be enjoyed in just about every part of the country.

Level 1 Scholarships: Individual - PADI Open Water Diver Course

Ten Scholarships of eLearning codes for Open Water Diver Course (\$190 value) will be presented annually. A random drawing by PADI following the deadline will determine the 10 recipients. Recipients will be notified by PADI. Codes must be issued within 12 months of the award.

Qualifications:

1. Individual must be a registered member of a Boy Scout Troop, Venturing Crew or Sea Scout Ship.
2. Individual must have parent or guardian approval if under 18 years of age.

Level 2 Scholarships: Individual - PADI Continuing Education Course

Five Scholarship of eLearning codes for Advanced Open Water or Rescue Diver (up to \$184 value) will be presented annually. A random drawing by PADI following the deadline will determine the 5 recipients. Recipients will be notified by PADI. Codes must be issued within 12 months of the award.

Qualifications:

1. Individual must be a registered member of a Boy Scout Troop, Venturing Crew or Sea Scout Ship.
2. Individual must have parent or guardian approval if under 18 years of age.
3. Must have a PADI Open Water Diver or Advanced Open Water (or equivalent) certification.

Level 3 Scholarships: Troop - PADI Open Water Diver Course

Five Boy Scout Troops, Venturing Crews and/or Sea Scout Ships of up to 8 members will receive scholarships of PADI Open Water Diver eLearning codes to use toward a PADI Open Water Diver Course. A random drawing by PADI following the deadline will determine the recipients. Recipients will be notified by PADI and the codes will be sent once a complete roster (including unique email addresses) is received by PADI. Codes must be issued within 12 months of the award.

Qualifications:

1. Individual must be a registered member of a Boy Scout Troop, Venturing Crew or Sea Scout Ship.
2. Individual must have parent or guardian approval if under 18 years of age.

Level 4 Scholarship: – Individual – Divemaster Course

Three Scholarships of materials for a PADI Divemaster course including eLearning codes and Crew Pak (\$655 value).

Following the application deadline, PADI will review all applications and select the most deserving applicant. Recipients will be notified by PADI. The scholarship must be used within 12 months of the award.

Qualification:

1. Must be registered with a Boy Scout troop, Venturing Crew or Sea Scout Ship and be at least 17 years of age to apply.
2. Must have a PADI Rescue Diver (or equivalent) certification.
3. Must submit 2 letters of recommendation.
4. Must submit an essay outlining background and experience in Scouting, and goals and objectives for diving.

Level 5 Scholarships: – Individual - PADI Instructor Development Materials

Three scholarship of materials for a PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor course including eLearning codes, Crew Pak, Instructor Examination Fees and IDC Registration Fees (\$2338 value). This scholarship is to be used by a chosen applicant to complete a PADI Instructor Development Course and subsequent Instructor Examination. Following the application deadline, PADI will review all applications and select the most deserving applicant. Recipients will be notified by PADI. The scholarship must be used within 12 months of the award.

Qualification:

1. Must be a registered member of a Boy Scout troop, Venturing Crew, or Sea Scout ship and be at least 17 years of age.
2. Must have a PADI Divemaster (or equivalent) certification.
3. Must submit two (2) letters of recommendation
4. Must submit an essay outlining background and experience in Scouting and your goals and objectives for diving.

Note: In all scholarships, the students unique email address will be required to send the eLearning Codes.
